

## Comprehension Lesson for the Fox's Warm Bargain

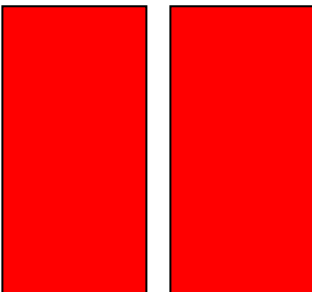

Objective: The students will be able to comprehend the story better after matching the first half of the five sentences below to the last half. The first sentence is done as an example.

**Challenge:** Write the first part of a sentence in one of the two boxes at the left below and the second part of the sentence in one of the boxes at the right. See if a friend can put both parts together and make sense.
