

Paired Reading - Rebus Reading Activity for The Hare That Ran Away



Divide the students into pairs. Have the students work together to figure out the story written in this rebus. Then ask them to take turns reading the story to each other. Have the students tell the story without the use of the rebus.

When you have done the above, tell the entire story to the students. Let them use the rebus as you repeat the story. Encourage the students to fill in the blanks as you tell the story – stopping where they should be able to contribute to the telling.
